Describing a Suspicious Incident

When you dial 911 from any home, business, or cellular phone anywhere in Garden City, you will be directly connected with the Savannah Chatham Metro Police Department Communications Center. They will then dispatch all calls to the appropriate municipality. **The Garden City Police Department encourages citizens to report any suspicious activity or person immediately.**

What happens once you call 911?

The Communications Operator will ask you a series of questions.

- Is this an emergency?
- What is the nature of the emergency?
- The operator will always ask for your location, name and or phone number to call back. You may elect to not give this information.
- Depending on the emergency, the operator may keep you on the line while at the same time sending out a police car.
- Description of Suspect, Victim, Vehicle & direction of travel

DESCRIBING PEOPLE:

Race	Hair (color, cut)
Sex	Build
Age	Eye Color
Height	Speech
Weight	Complexion
Clothing	Glasses
Visible Marks/Scars	Direction of Travel

EXAMPLE: *Male, white, approximately 45 years old, between 5'6" and 5'8", 150 pounds, medium build, gray hair, long sideburns, wearing a blue baseball cap, no coat, white shirt, dark pants, and sneakers. He was last seen east bound on Smith Ave from Main Street on foot.*

Identifying Marks (body damage, bumper stickers, etc.)
